

FIRST HOUSE: The Subject/Victim

- **1st House Ruler in the 1st House:** Subject feels safe and in their element.
- **7th House Ruler in the 1st House:** Presence of another person, often significant (potentially abductor/murderer).
- **4th House Ruler in the 1st House:** Influence of family/home environment on the subject or event.
- **10th House Ruler in the 1st House:** Presence of an authority figure (boss, parent, police) at the scene or influencing the subject.
- **Mars, Pluto, Uranus in the 1st House:** Suggests unexpected events or aggression.
- **Moon in the 1st House:** Similar to the 1st house ruler in the 1st house, indicating the subject's immediate state.
- **Neptune in the 1st House:** Indicates a secret situation (hiding or being hidden). If Neptune also rules the 7th, it suggests a secret person (e.g., stalker). Can also imply substance abuse (check other placements).
- **5th House Ruler in the 1st House:** Presence of a child.
- **11th House Ruler in the 1st House:** Presence of a past partner (often ex-spouse).
- **8th House Ruler or Saturn in the 1st House:** Potential beginning of a death pattern (verify with other chart placements).

FOURTH HOUSE: Home and Family

- **1st House Ruler in the 4th House:** Subject at home or in their neighborhood.
- **10th House Ruler in the 4th House:** Subject in a public, often commercial, establishment.
- **4th House Ruler in the 4th House:** Family involvement and/or the family home is significant.
- **5th House Ruler in the 4th House:** Children present in the subject's home.
- **7th House Ruler in the 4th House:** Someone entering the subject's home (invited or forced entry).
- **8th House Ruler in the 4th House:** Potential beginning of a death pattern (check for completion elsewhere).
- **9th House Ruler in the 4th House:** Presence of a foreigner or someone of a different culture in the subject's home. If with the 7th house ruler, the person entering is likely of a different race or culture.
- **11th House Ruler in the 4th House:** Visit from an ex-spouse or a gathering of friends at the subject's home.
- **12th House Ruler in the 4th House:** Potential beginning of a death pattern or indicates a funeral/burial.

- **2nd House Ruler in the 4th House:** Presence of a valuable item belonging to the subject (possibly stolen or still in possession).

SEVENTH HOUSE: Encounters and Others

- **1st House Ruler in the 7th House:** Meeting between the subject and another person involved in the event (potential ally or adversary). Could mark the arrival of an abductor/murderer.
- **10th House Ruler in the 7th House:** Encounter with someone in authority.
- **3rd House Ruler in the 7th or 7th House Ruler in the 3rd House:** Subject knows the other person (neighbor, sibling, coworker, classmate), likely met nearby. 7th ruler in the 3rd can also indicate someone in a vehicle.
- **6th House Ruler in the 7th or 7th House Ruler in the 6th House:** Workplace is a factor in the meeting. 7th ruler in the 6th suggests the other person was at work at the time.
- **7th House Ruler in the 11th House:** Abductor/rapist was a friend or acquaintance.
- **7th House Ruler in the 1st House:** Confrontation; the subject was likely surprised.
- **7th House Ruler in the 4th House:** Someone entering the subject's home. 7th ruler in the 10th: meeting in a public place.
- **7th House Ruler in the 2nd House:** Robbery. 2nd ruler in the 7th: the other person possesses something belonging to the victim.
- **7th House Ruler in the 8th House:** Description of a dangerous, criminal, or sleazy person.
- **7th House Ruler in the 5th House:** The other person may be a child/young person. Can indicate rape if other aspects support it.

TENTH HOUSE: Public Life and Authority

- **10th House Ruler in the 1st House:** Presence of a powerful person, often a father figure.
- **1st House Ruler in the 10th House:** Subject was in a position of power (supervisor, public official) or in the company of an employee/dependent.
- **3rd House Ruler in the 10th House:** Subject may be looking for a ride or hitchhiking in a public area (e.g., highway).
- **8th House Ruler in the 10th House:** Potential rape in a public place. If part of a death pattern, death/murder occurred publicly.
- **11th House Ruler in the 10th House:** Subject with an influential friend or has left to pursue a dream.
- **9th House Ruler in the 10th House or conjunct the Midheaven:** Subject in the company of foreigners, at school/on school grounds, in court/jail, or has traveled abroad (check other indicators). 10th ruler in the 9th can also suggest these scenarios.
- **6th House Ruler in the 10th House:** Subject concerned about work/health. 10th ruler in the 6th: subject may work in healthcare, went to a job interview, or disappeared from work.

- **12th House Ruler in the 10th House:** Burial in a public place; the body may be exposed.
- **10th House Ruler in the 12th House:** Someone important is keeping the subject's whereabouts secret (sometimes a parent).
- **4th or 1st House Ruler in the 10th House:** Subject may be in the abductor's home. The Midheaven's sign can indicate the location.

Understanding Astrological Houses in Forensic Charts

- **1st House: The Individual (Subject/Victim)**
 - Represents the person, their personality, appearance, and immediate behavior.
 - Indicates their current actions and location.
 - Planets here reveal if their actions are voluntary or forced, aiding in distinguishing runaway from abduction cases.
- **2nd House: Possessions and Concerns**
 - Governs material belongings (with them or of concern).
 - Often signifies locations like banks, safe deposit boxes, purses, car trunks, and storage units.
 - Planets highlight the subject's immediate concerns, potentially revealing if money is a central aspect of the case.
- **3rd House: Movement and Communication**
 - Describes the subject's movements (on foot or by vehicle), including the type of vehicle.
 - Indicates direction and general area of travel.
 - Governs interactions, conversations, and communication methods (e.g., phone use).
 - Planets and the ruling planet can help track cell phone pings.
- **4th House: Home and Immediate Environment**
 - Represents the home, residence, or the subject's current location.
 - Can indicate if the subject is in a dwelling and potentially whose home it is (details revealed by planets and aspects).
 - Shows the subject's connection to their family home and the family in general.
- **5th House: Interests and Leisure**
 - Governs outside interests: entertainment, sports, music, pleasure, children, parties, alcohol, and drug use.
 - Planetary placements can indicate the presence of children, social gatherings, substance involvement, or recreational activities.

- Relevant in cases where the subject disappears from places like sports fields.
- **6th House: Work and Health**
 - Represents the subject's employment and their health status (including potential illness or grave danger).
 - Can point to coworkers and workplaces.
 - Reveals if coworkers are involved or if the subject is with someone ill and dependent.
- **7th House: The Other Person (Often the Antagonist)**
 - Frequently signifies the abductor, murderer, kidnapper, accomplice, or co-conspirator.
 - In runaway cases with assistance, the ruler indicates the helper.
 - Most often describes the individual directly involved in the subject's disappearance or death (friend, lover, spouse, stranger, etc.).
- **8th House: The Darker Aspects**
 - Often describes the subject's death and is crucial in identifying "death patterns."
 - Represents criminals, desperate individuals, drug addicts (especially with 5th house indicators), sexual activity, other people's finances, and theft.
 - Also governs wills, probate, insurance, bank accounts, and the financial resources of involved parties.
- **9th House: Broader Horizons and Legalities**
 - Covers diverse areas: the outdoors, outdoor activities (hunting, camping), educational institutions (schools, students, teachers), travel (long distances, highways, air travel), foreigners/immigrants, and legal matters (laws, lawyers, authorities, police).
 - Requires strong intuition and understanding of planetary and sign placements for proper analysis.
- **10th House: Public Image and Spaces**
 - Generally represents public perception of the case and potential media attention. Strong placements can indicate high-profile cases.
 - Can signify public locations (government buildings, general public spaces).
 - Often indicates the subject was in a visible, public area, relevant in "snatching" scenarios.
 - Analysis can offer insights into the likelihood and timeline of case resolution.
- **11th House: Social Connections and Aspirations**
 - Governs friends, acquaintances, and recent contacts who may be significant to the case.

- Can show the subject with friends or at group gatherings.
- Also relates to extramarital affairs/looming divorce as potential motives.
- Represents the subject's hopes, dreams, and desires, often relevant in cases where the subject left voluntarily to pursue them.

- **12th House: Endings and Confinement**

- Represents the end of life and the isolation of dying.
- Can describe hidden, dark, or confined spaces.
- Signifies being held against one's will.
- Integral to "death patterns" and can indicate burial locations.
- Planets like Saturn or Pluto here, as well as the 1st house ruler or Moon in the 12th, can indicate death.

☒ **Mirach:** 29 degrees 01 minutes Aries: can mean drunkenness or drugs.

☒ **Schedir:** 7 degrees 47 minutes Taurus: can indicate escape or being set free.

☒ **The Pleiades:** 28 degrees Taurus: can portend the death of many people, all at once or over time. A situation creating great sadness; tears.

☒ **Caput Algol or Algol:** 24 degrees 46 minutes Taurus: can mean murder, mayhem & bloodshed.

☒ **Miram:** 27 degrees 19 minutes Taurus: can mean someone is lying.

☒ **Hoedus:** 17 degrees 14 minutes Gemini: can define lust, rape, lascivious behavior.

☒ **Al Hecka:** 23 degrees 23 minutes Gemini: can point to pedophilia or other deviation.

☒ **Betelgeuse:** 27 degrees 21 minutes Gemini: can point to accidental death.

☒ **Sirius:** 12 degrees 42 minutes Cancer: can mean danger in the night.

☒ **Geidi Prima:** 18 degrees 51 minutes Cancer: can mean rape has been committed.

☒ **Pollux:** 21 degrees 50 minutes Cancer: can indicate misfortune or calamity.

☒ **Asellus Boreali:** 6 degrees 9 minutes Leo: can mean murder by shooting.

☒ **Asellus Austral:** 7 degrees 19 minutes Leo: can mean murder by decapitation or hanging.

☒ **Asellus Austral:** 7 degrees 19 minutes Leo: can describe a sleazy, criminal person.

☒ **Phecda:** 29 degrees 4 minutes Leo: can mean a pathological sex addict.

☒ **Alfard:** 25 degrees 53 minutes Leo: can mean death by asphyxiation or strangulation.

☒ **Alfard:** 25 degrees 53 minutes Leo: can mean death by drowning.

☒ **Vindemiatrix:** 8 degrees 33 minutes Libra: can mean accidental death.

☒ **Vindematrix:** 8 degrees 33 minutes Libra: can mean someone will be rescued.

- ❓ **Spica:** 22 degrees 27 minutes Libra: can mean insight, kindness and a turn for the better.
- ❓ **Unukalhai:** 20 degrees 40 minutes Scorpio: can mean drugs.
- ❓ **Polis:** 28 degrees 13 minutes Scorpio: can indicate drunkenness or drug abuse.
- ❓ **Kelb Alrai:** 7 degrees 50 minutes Sagittarius: can indicate poisoning.
- ❓ **Dschubba:** 10 degrees 10 minutes Sagittarius: can mean murder.
- ❓ **Sabik:** 16 degrees 34 minutes Sagittarius: can mean perversion or perversity.
- ❓ **Ras Algethi:** 14 degrees 45 minutes Sagittarius: can mean a devious plot is involved.
- ❓ **Sinistra:** 28 degrees 21 minutes Sagittarius: can mean obsessive, wanton lust and sexual attack.
- ❓ **Manubrium:** 13 degrees 36 minutes Capricorn: can describe burning of a body or an arson.
- ❓ **Fomalhaut:** 2 degrees 27 minutes Pisces: can mean drug addiction.
- ❓ **Markab:** 22 degrees 6 minutes Pisces; can describe shooting or being shot with a gun.
- ❓ **Scheat:** 27 degrees 59 minutes Pisces: can mean death by drowning.

The Sun

- **Gender:** Usually male influence, but not always; check supporting aspects. No planet inherently gives sex.
- **Danger:** A place of great danger if angular planets or chart rulers are within 17 degrees.
 - Especially true for the Moon or planets ruling/in the first house.
 - Sun in the first house with other angular-ruling planets suggests danger from a male aggressor.
 - Mars aspects double this influence.

The Moon

- **Importance:** Always the chart co-ruler, regardless of sign or house.
- **Markers:** Any planet aspecting, disposing of, or in the same house (aspected or not) is important.
- **Subject:** Read with the same importance as the first house ruler; aspects describe the subject's condition.
- **Power:** Doesn't need to be angular to be powerful.
- **Secondary Ruler:** Almost always the secondary marker for the subject (missing person, lost item, etc.).
- **Equal Power:** Equal in power to the first house ruler.

Mercury

- **Children (Unsure Cases):** Use as the ruler if the subject is a child unsupervised, or if the inquirer is not a family member.
 - Moon is the co-ruler in these cases.
- **Children (Parent Involved):** Use the fifth house ruler for the child and the first house for the parent.
 - Mercury can be a co-ruler for the child, Moon for the parent (especially mom).
- **Non-Children:**
 - **Vehicles/Movement:** Can represent cars, trucks, walking, driving, running.
 - **First House Dispositor:** Subject is "on the move".
 - **Third House Ruler:** Cars, transportation, commerce, trade, neighbors.
 - **Tenth House:** Business district, commercial district.
 - **Fourth House Ruler:** "Removable" housing (trailer, RV, etc.).
 - **Seventh House Ruler:** Accomplice, murderer, abductor, enabler, or partner may be a child; the thief may be a child.
 - Placement of Mercury (ruling 7th) in other houses is important.

- **Tenth House Ruler in Seventh:** Subject's boss, superior, authority figure (father, police officer, politician).

Venus and Mars

- **Gender:** Variable as angular rulers; cannot solely determine sex.
- **Situations/Actions:** Often describe situations or actions.
- **Mars:**
 - **Aggression:** Can describe aggression.
 - **Mars in First House:** Aggression towards the subject.
 - **Mars Rules Seventh in First:** Violence towards the subject from another person.
 - **Mars in Tenth:** Masculine presence or situation around masculine symbols (auto shops, racetracks).
 - **Mars in Fourth:** Male presence in the home.
 - **Mars Rules Seventh (Anywhere):** Someone being aggressive in that area (angular houses most important).
 - **Mars Rules Seventh in Ninth:** Person may be a hunter.
 - **Mars Rules First:** Marker for the subject, does not imply aggression.
 - **House Rulership of Mars:** Tells who you are dealing with.
 - **House Placement of Mars:** Shows what that person is doing.
- **Venus:**
 - **Soft Influence:** Most often depicts a mother or motherly presence.
 - **Females (Not Always):** Can represent females, but also feminine males, single fathers, artists, etc.
 - **Emotions/Attraction:** Describes emotions between people and romantic attraction.
 - **Sun and Venus:** Together can describe a couple, especially ruling angles.
 - **Descriptor:** Most often used as a descriptor rather than an active force.

Jupiter

- **Person (Rare):** Rarely a person, but can describe an overweight onlooker/witness.
- **Police:** Sometimes describes the police (Sagittarius on 9th/10th cusp).
- **Scenery/Objects (Most Often):** Church, school, bakery, candy shop, etc.
 - Sign and house placement determine the place or scenery.
- **Person (Possible):** Priest, teacher, guru, supporter, chef, book publisher, etc.

Saturn

- **Human Body:** Represents the human body; traditionally rules bones.
- **Location of Body (Post-Death Pattern):** Describes the location of the body.
 - **Second House:** Trunk of a car.
 - **Third House:** In the car, but not the trunk.
 - **Ninth House:** Outdoors, likely woods.
 - **Fourth House:** Place of business (warehouse, garage - especially with Gemini or near Mercury).
 - **Twelfth House:** Body very well hidden.
 - **Water Sign:** Look for water.
 - **Earth Sign:** Probably buried.
 - **Air Sign:** High place (mountainside, shelf, roof, ceiling).
 - **Fire Sign:** Look for signs of burning.

Uranus

- **Unusual Events/People:** Describes unusual, unexpected events and people.
- **Eccentricities/Antiques/Science:** Eccentricities, antiques, scientific equipment, laboratories, experiments.
- **Technology/Transportation:** Airplanes, airstrips, radios, towers, TV, satellites, missiles.
- **Unusual People:** People on the edge, homeless, brilliant.
- **Guru (with Neptune):** Combined with Neptune, can indicate a guru.
- **Location of Body (Often):** Most often used to locate the body.
 - **Angular/Aspects to Rulers (especially Saturn):** Helps describe the location.
 - **Unusual Landscape:** Look for something unusual in the landscape.

Neptune

- **Hidden Factors:** Describes hidden factors, lies, pretensions, shams.
- **Plots/Schemes:** Can indicate plots and schemes (especially with the Node).
- **Fifth House:** Drugs or alcohol.
- **Twelfth House:** Unconsciousness.
- **Eighth House:** Drug overdose.
- **Seventh House:** Person not who they seem or unknown person involved.
 - Often appears when a second, unsuspected party is involved.
- **Second House:** Scam for money.
- **Tenth House:** Lying about career or job.

- **Sixth House:** Hidden illness.

Pluto

- **Chaos/Destruction:** Describes chaos, destruction, upsets, fights, explosions, aggression, physical violence, disorder, riots.
- **Fifth/Eighth House:** Violent rape.
- **Eighth/Twelfth House:** Violent death.
- **Fourth House:** Disruption in the current location (home, living place).
- **Tenth House:** Disruption in a public place (retail store, business).
- **Sixth House:** Disruption or violence in the workplace; unpleasant big changes at work.
- **Third House:** Car accident (especially if 3rd ruler in 9th or is Gemini).
- **Pluto Rules Fourth in Fifth:** Child was abducted.
